

## Application For IOOF Co-Hosted Fundraising Events Instructions

The goal of the Community Support Committee is to select events that will benefit non-profit organizations or public school events. The Committee considers the application and collectively approves or denies the request to cohost an event based on the application and any other information the organization might provide. Requests for Friday or Saturday co-hosted events require special consideration which includes approval by the IOOF Hall Board which meets one time a month. Applications will not be considered more than 4 months in advance. If approved, the Lodge will require a \$300 refundable security deposit.

To obtain an application, you can go to the Odd Fellows Hall and pick one up, or go to the Odd Fellows web site and download the "Application for IOOF Co-Hosted Fundraising Events." Fill out the form, and mail it to:

Upon selection, the Community Support Committee will request you to provide a budget for approval for the event. **Original itemized receipts need to be presented for reimbursement.**
